COVID-19 UPDATE



To our most valued customers,

As the Ohio Department of Transportation is nearing completion on another phase of replacing the Stewart Road bridge deck, they will be closing the Stewart Road exit on I-71 northbound starting July 31st. The current estimated time for the project completion and the exit to remain closed is 75 days. Thankfully this only impacts our northbound traffic. In the meantime, here are directions on how to get to The BMW Store & Cincinnati MINI coming north on I-71:

- • Take the Kenwood Road exit (one exit after Stewart Rd)
- • Right off the exit
- • Right on Euclid (first intersection you come to)
- • Straight through the stop sign
- • Left onto Stewart Road at the light
- • Follow that down until you see us on the right

As always, we are happy to schedule a premium valet pick up and/or drop off if that is more convenient for you.

Of course, we are still sanitizing and practicing social distancing with our customers, we are all wearing masks and following the other recommendations made by the Governor and the CDC to keep everyone safe. We kindly ask for you to wear a mask when visiting the dealership.

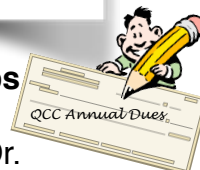

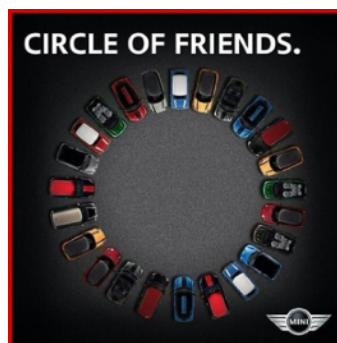
