
Hello fellow Miniacs!

Getting Your MINI Cooper Winterized

When you stop by for your MINI service, these are just a few of the steps taken to make sure your car is winter-ready:

- **Tires:** Checking the tread, air pressure, and alignment is important for safe driving. You can also opt for a set of MINI Cooper winter wheels and tires for even greater traction on slick surfaces.
- **Battery:** Dropping temperatures can cause major issues for your battery capacity. Your technician will check your battery for any damage as well as charge level, so you can get a replacement before you run into trouble.
- **Belts and Hoses:** Cold temperatures can turn belts and hoses brittle, so a quick inspection can help you stay on top of your components before they suffer damage.
- **Brakes:** Brake pads and rotors should be checked for performance, since harsh winter weather can cause your brakes to work harder.
- **Antifreeze and Coolant:** These components are vital for your engine's temperature regulation. Ask the parts department for antifreeze recommendations during your MINI service if you aren't sure what to use.
- **Engine Oil:** Your engine oil can thicken during colder temperatures, which can cause damage if your oil is already old and viscous. We recommend scheduling an oil change before the colder temperatures set in.
- **Windshield Wipers and Fluid:** Your wipers can crack and split, which can render them worthless against winter precipitation. Additionally, you'll want to switch to freeze-proof wiper fluid that won't compromise your clarity on the Carlsbad roads.
- **Lights:** Lighting systems like turn signals, fog lights, headlights and tail lights should all be checked – and you can even upgrade to brighter, more efficient LED lighting at our service department.


