We pulled out of the parking lot just before 7:00 for a drive along the Ohio River to Carrollton, KY and our lodging for the weekend at General Butler State Park.

The sun was shining on a cool Saturday morning for our first day of exploring. After breakfast at the Lodge, we headed out for our first stop - the Howard Steamboat Museum. This was the home of the Howard family, builders of steamboats. It is a very eclectic mansion with steamboat memorabilia and lore on the second and third floors. After lunch nearby, we caravanned to the Falls of the Ohio State Park for the afternoon. The wheels came off our route planning as we drove from the Falls to LaGrange, KY for dinner. Downtown Louisville was crawling with people - streets were blocked off, others were one-way (often the wrong way!). Sunday was a bit warmer but still sunny for our second day of driving. Our first stop was the Medora Covered Bridge. We did enjoy some good roads, passed Lock #3 on the Kentucky River, and got to Owenton for a bio break. Seven cars headed for home, while three cars continued on the last loop before ending the drive.




