Meet at the park at 9:00am, drivers meeting will be at 9:15, with the drive starting immediately after (around 9:30).

Date: Friday October 20 - 22



Friday - starting with a full gas tank and empty bladder, using non-interstate routes to Zanesville - arrive at hotel by 7:00.






