#### HERE ARE SOME PLACES WE MAY DRIVE BY:

Hindu Temple of Greater Cincinnati is a spiritual sanctuary welcoming all who enter. A place where families come together and share in the serenity and beauty of the Hindu way of life. A magnificent place of worship with 16 breathtaking Deities. The Hindu Temple's stunning architecture sits atop 100 acres of prime wooded land and as you drive through the large iron gates, you will feel it's peace and tranquility.

2848 Route 50 is the home of Motorsports Country Club of Cincinnati. It is a private club. Look on your left for the white cross hatched fence and an old farmhouse. It is after Clermont County School and just after Hutchinson Road. "We love karting! Our vision is to provide a local establishment where members and their families can satisfy their "need for speed" or just relax in a comfortable motorsports atmosphere. Our 5000 sq ft building includes a full service clubhouse with men's and women's locker rooms, a kitchen, dining room, observation deck of the outdoor track, and lounge area. At MCC, you are able to rent, bring your own kart, or store it here for convenience."

The Hartman Log Cabin at 5272 Aber Road in Williamsburg, Ohio 45176 is next to Route 50. This historic log cabin, dating back to 1838, was restored by CECOS International in 1993, when it was donated to the park district. The park features a picnic shelter and barn as well as a walking trail to the Jackson Township Pioneer Cemetery. The cabin, barn and picnic shelter are all available to rent for small gatherings and celebrations.

The name Marathon comes from the legend of Pheidippides, a Greek messenger. The legend states he was sent from the battlefield of Marathon to Athens to announce that the Persians had been defeated, which took place in August or September, 490 BC. He ran the 26.2 miles from Marathon to Athens to announce the Greek victory and died on the spot.

The McCafferty Road Covered Bridge, in Brown County, Ohio, is a 160 foot historic covered bridge built in 1877. Located in the unincorporated community of Vera Cruz, it spans the East Fork of the Little Miami River. It was built in 1877 by the Smith Bridge Company. There looks to be 5 covered bridges left in this county, four are still open to traffic.

At 5552 Bucktown Road you will see Grant's Farm. "We are a family greenhouse operation. We grow annuals, perennials, vegetables, and herbs to sell in our retail stores and wholesale. We also sell straw and Ertl toys. We have a large selection of trees and shrubs. The farm is open year-round!"

The Stonelick Covered Bridge is located on Stonelick-Williams Corner Road in Clermont County, Ohio, crossing the Stonelick Creek. The one-lane covered bridge was built in 1878. It is 140 feet long and supported using a 12-panel Howe truss. Almost 50 covered bridges were built in Clermont County, Ohio between 1825 and 1878, yet only THIS ONE remains. This bridge has come close to being lost several times, including once when a garbage truck partially fell through the floor of the structure. In that incident in order to save the bridge, the floor of the bridge had to be cut open to let the truck slowly drop into the creek below! Then it drove up the bank and went on it's trashy way.

Close after this bridge is Saint Philomena Church. The parish of St. Philomena was established in 1839 and was sometimes referred to as the Little Church in the Valley. It has the distinction of being the oldest Catholic Church in Clermont County! The founders of the church were residents of the area before Ohio become a state in 1803.

There are two cemeteries at the church. One the "old cemetery," at which burials were made until the late 1800s. Many of the burials were children less than one year of age who dies due to the hardships of the wilderness. Burials of Civil War veterans were also made in this cemetery. The "new cemetery" was dedicated in 1890. Many veterans from the area who served in the wars between 1900 and today are buried in this cemetery. The cemetery is currently still in use and both cemeteries are a tribute to the history of Catholicism in the Stonelick area.
